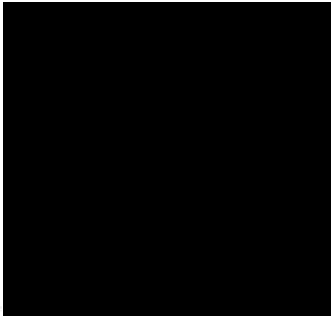

Re: Freedom of Information Request: [subject]

We write further to your request dated 23rd February 2020 which was received on 23rd February 2020 and which states:

“What is the total cost and number of folk using the kerbside collection service during the past 12 months”

The response to your question is :

1. The Commissioners have a collection only contract for kerbside recycling and the annual cost for 2019/20 was £30,000. It incurs no costs for bulking up or transportation but receives no income from the materials recycled.
2. Two participation surveys were undertaken in 2019. There are 1350 residential properties in the Parish and in May the survey showed a 37% participation rate and in December 34% participation.

Your right to request a review

investing in children

Your review request should explain why you are dissatisfied with this response, and should be made as soon as practicable. We will respond as soon as the review has been concluded.

If you are not satisfied with the result of the review, you then have the right to apply for a review of decisions by the Information Commissioner, for a decision on;

1. Whether we have responded to your request for information in accordance with Part 2 of the Freedom of Information Act 2015; or
2. Whether we are justified in refusing to give you the information requested.

In response to an application for review, the Information Commissioner may, at any time, attempt to resolve a matter by negotiation, conciliation, mediation or another form of alternative dispute resolution and will have regard to any outcome of this in making any subsequent decision.
